

#### **EDITORIAL**



This year we mark the centenary of the end of World War 1. On Remembrance Sunday 11 November 2018, people all around the country will be reflecting on the lives that were

changed irrevocably, and those that were lost.

Some 65 million men were mobilised across Europe during World War 1. Nearly a third of them – some 21 million – were wounded.

Another 8.5 million were killed and some 7.7 million were taken prisoners of war. All of them had family and friends whose lives were changed forever by the events of 1914-1918.

The red remembrance poppy has become a familiar emblem of Remembrance Day due to the poem "In Flanders Fields" written by Canadian physician Lieutenant-Colonel John McCrae. After reading the poem, Moina Michael, a professor at the University of Georgia, wrote the poem, "We Shall Keep the Faith," and swore to wear a red poppy on the anniversary. The custom spread to Europe and the countries of the British Empire and Commonwealth within three years. Madame Anne E. Guerin tirelessly promoted the practice in Europe and the British Empire. In the UK Major George Howson fostered the cause with the support of General Haia. Poppies were worn for the first time at the 1921 anniversary ceremony. At first real poppies were worn. These poppies bloomed across some of the worst battlefields of Flanders in World War I: their brilliant red colour became a symbol for the blood spilled

in the war.

This marks a poignant tradition each year to remember all those millions of individuals who gave their todays for our tomorrows. Perhaps we should all reflect on how we would react to the same situation they faced? Would we, of this modern age, compare favourably with those ordinary men and women that made huge sacrifices?

Should we, of this modern age, perhaps give thanks that we aren't facing those terrible choices that our grandparents and great grandparents faced in the war to end all wars?

Looking forward, join us on Sunday 25th November for our Christmas Fayre at Cedars Park Community Centre 12-4pm, raising money for The Williams Syndrome Foundation. Plenty of stalls, Santa's Grotto, Cedars Park Primary School Choir, Face painting, Cedars Park Preschool Crafts and singing, Festive Food and Drink, Raffles and so much more.

Also for all the Elvis fans we have the fantastic Andy Ottley on the 24th November at The Aviary 7-1 lpm.
